The IMMAJ-PJMCC Foundation, Inc., conducted a 10 day-training course for instructors known as the IMO Model Course 6.09 from April 25, 2016 to May 6, 2016 at the JSU-AMOSUP Mariners' Home, 1765 Vazquez St. Cor.
