This training course utilizes a fully-functional JRC ECDIS equipment models JRC JAN 9201/7201/701/901/901M and 701B/901B/2000 series typically found onboard modern ships. It is capable of demonstrating all functions, including chart set-up, manuals, documentations, chart handling, and software updating. It also has sensors, alarms for collision avoidance, and tools for loading and monitoring the ship's planned route.

Reasons to Attend the Course

The main goal of this course is to provide the Officer-In-Charge of navigational watch with the knowledge and proficiency in the use of JRC brand models within the series. Those successfully completing this training shall have necessary confidence in operating JRC ECDIS equipment for planning, conducting and monitoring navigation using electronic charts, thus fulfilling the STCW-2010 regulation II/1 and II/2 with reference to A-II/1 and A-II/2.
