Simulator / Facility

This training course utilizes a fully-functional TOKYO KEIKI ECDIS equipment models EC-8000/8500 and EC-8100/8600 series typically found onboard modern ships. It is capable of demonstrating ECDIS set-up, manual operation, chart handling, and software updating. It also has sensors, alarms for errors and other tools for loading and monitoring the ship's planned route.

Reasons to Attend the Course

The main goal of this course is to provide the Officer-In-Charge of navigational watch with the knowledge and proficiency in the use of TOKYO KEIKI brand models within the series. Those successfully completing this specific training shall have necessary confidence in operating TOKYO KEIKI ECDIS equipment for planning and monitoring safe navigation using electronic charts, thus fulfilling the STCW-2010 regulation II/1 and II/2 to STCW-2010 code A-II/1 and A-II/2.
