It can be programmed to simulate different shi conditions, and environment. Other practical exercises are conducted in our mooring workshop which deck work maintenance tools and equipment.

Reasons to Attend the Course

This course provides training for senior deck ratings and other ratings with potential for promotion to seni to develop their leadership, management, communication and technical skills to ensure safe and operation. At the end of this training, trainees will gain a good understanding of the minimum standards required in Section A-II/4 and Section-II/5 of the STCW Code 1978, as amended, such as helmsmansh rope handling, knots and splices, deck work maintenance, pumping of bilges, and anchor works.
