About the Course

This course was designed by IMO to facilitate the delivery of training in the competence standards of the IMO STCW Convention, 1978, as amended (2010 Manila Amendments). The course is intended for operational and management level shipboard officers as well as senior ratings who are interested to obtain a Maritime Training Certificate and license to teach STCW-required training programs. The objectives of this course include the preparation of effective teaching and instruction, the selection of appropriate methods of instruction, the selection of appropriate teaching materials, and the evaluation of the teaching and learning processes.

Reasons to Attend the Course

Completion of the IMO Model Course 6.09, Training Course for Instructors, is a requirement for becoming an instructor in all Maritime Higher Education Institutions (MHEIs) and Maritime Training Institutions (MTIs). Completion of the course will result in the issuance of a certificate of qualification as Instructor in any MHEI or MTI to holders of the MARINA Model Course 6.09 certificate.
