Simulator / Facility

The wood chip carrier facility at MOLTCP is the same unloading equipment used to unload wood chip carrier vessels. It is installed with original conveyor system and grab bucket; which is used to enhance trainees when it comes to safety operation and proper maintenance of cargo devices.

Reasons to Attend the Course

The course covers the maintenance and safety handling of cargo gears to avoid accidents and delay which may occur onboard ship. At the end of the course, the trainees shall be able to: 1.) identify suitable maintenance and safety handling of cargo gears; 2.) explain the operational, cargo care and maintenance efficiency of cargo gears; 3.) demonstrate the proper procedure of dismantling and assembling of grab bucket tie rod, inspection and maintenance of pin and bush, sheaved guide, wire guide roller, wire guide and holding chain and 4.) demonstrate the maintenance and maintenance of conveyor system.
