Simulator / Facility

Trainees will have access to our bridge simulator to acquire the required skills in helmsmanship and watchkeeping. The JMS full mission shiphhandling simulator provides a training environment based on an actual ship's navigation operations performed onboard a ship. It can be programmed to simulate different ship conditions, and environment. Other practical exercises are conducted in our mooring workshop which includes deck work maintenance tools and equipment.

Reasons to Attend the Course

This course provides training for senior deck ratings and other ratings with potential for promotion to senior ratings. It aims to develop their leadership, management, communication and technical skills to ensure safe and efficient ship operation. At the end of this training, trainees will gain a good understanding of the minimum standards required in Section A-II/4 and Section-II/5 of the STCW Code 1978, as amended, such as helmsmanship, mooring, rope handling, knots and splices, deck work maintenance, pumping of bilges, and anchor works.
